



## VOTING MADE SIMPLE

### HOW TO VOTE 2020

This IS the MOST IMPORTANT ELECTION IN MODERN HISTORY.  
Let's make sure ALL OF US are on the RIGHT SIDE OF HISTORY and VOTE.

#### VOTE FROM HOME

- IF you have already requested and received your absentee ballot you can VOTE from home. It's easy and convenient!
  1. Complete your ballot and seal it in the envelope! READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. Use black or blue pen.
  2. Sign the signature envelope and seal the envelope inside! Remember to add the ID number you used when you applied.
  3. Don't forget to place a stamp on the envelope.
  4. Mail your ballot OR drop it off at your County Election drop box.

#### VOTE EARLY IN PERSON

- Early in-person voting starts on September 18 through 5:00 p.m. November 2. If you have not received an Absentee ballot, you can VOTE in person at your County Elections office.

#### VOTE ON ELECTION DAY: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020

- Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. As long as you're in line before 8:00 p.m., you can CAST YOUR VOTE!

#### NEED TO REGISTER TO VOTE?

- Register to VOTE online by October 13, 2020. Go to: [mnvotes.org](http://mnvotes.org). OR in person at: Secretary of State, 60 Empire Drive, Ste. 100, St. Paul, MN 55103
- You can register to VOTE on Election Day at your correct polling place. Must be eligible to vote and show proof of your name & current address.
- If you had a felony conviction, you can VOTE after you finish all parts of your sentence (probation, parole, and other restitution).
